### ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all Belgian Tervuren dogs over the age of 12 months that are registered with the AKC or that have obtained AKC ILP numbers, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. This trial will be run under the revised Regulations for Agility Trials effective September 1, 2002 & subsequent amendments.

### MOVE UP

**Prior to the Trial:** Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, **IN WRITING** (e-mail is OK), not later than Monday, Noon, April 24, 2006. **E-mail requests will be acknowledged upon receipt.**

**Day to Day Move Ups:** Move ups from Monday to Tuesday will be allowed. The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary not later than one hour after the final class on Monday.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE SPECIALTY SITE

The specialty site is conveniently located on U.S. Highway 11, two miles from the Pennsylvania Turnpike (Interstate) at exit 226, or exit 52 from Interstate 81.

Please enclose a photocopy of your dog's AKC Jump Height Card, if you have one, with your entry form. For dogs two years and older: Owners/Handlers must present a permanent height card at check-in, or be measured prior to competing. For dogs under two years of age: The Owner/Handler must present a temporary height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing. The measuring of dogs shall be done by a Judge of Record for these trials, or a measuring official, if present.

## CLASS INFORMATION AND OBSTACLES

Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Complete rules can be found on the AKC website at [www.akc.org](http://www.akc.org). For a copy of the rule book, write to: American Kennel Club, 5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606-3390. Obstacles will conform to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog entered in the trial. Regular class dogs may run in a higher height division, but not a lower one. Preferred class dogs MAY NOT run in a higher height division. In no case may a dog be moved down in height based on a judge's measurement at a trial.

## COURSE FAMILIARIZATION / WARM UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. The walk through period will be held prior to each class, following the judge's briefing. A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors. Exhibitors may not use the warm up area to relieve their dogs.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- ENTRY RECEIPT: If you wish confirmation of RECEIPT of your entries, you must provide a valid, un-blocked e-mail address, or you may enclose a pre-addressed, pre-paid postcard. A MAXIMUM OF 10 ENTRIES PER ENVELOPE.
- FINAL CONFIRMATIONS: Entries including a valid, unblocked e-mail address will receive confirmations via e-mail. Entries without a valid e-mail address will receive confirmations via the US Post Office. If you provided an e-mail address but wish to receive your final confirmation via the US Post Office, please contact the Trial Secretary.
- Please include only AKC titles on your entry form (NO CGC or HICs).
- Telegraph, telephone, fax, unsigned or otherwise incomplete, or entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC agility entry form or photocopies of the entry form without the agreement & rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.
- Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- Make checks payable to ABTC-2006.
- Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete, the club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive **written notification** by letter postmarked **before Monday, Noon, April 24, 2006** to claim a refund for a bitch in season. A refund check will be sent after the completion of the national specialty.
- Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. ABTC assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- ABTC may decline any entries & may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, & no one shall have any claim against ABTC or any official thereof.
- Errors on entry forms - owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whosoever may make such errors, & no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of such entries after the closing date. Please type or print carefully the information on the entry forms to eliminate errors.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Agility Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Agility Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates, except when being judged & in the Warm Up area. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the premises. Safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering the trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with & able to perform obstacles safely.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks.
- At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat (buckle or quick release) collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or other attachments. Choke collars, pinch collars, electric & dummy electric collars are prohibited. Food & toys are not permitted on the course area & handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices.
- Exhibitors assume all risk of leaving items overnight. ABTC will not be responsible for any loss or damage to items at the show site.
