**Entries close on Wednesday, August 31, 2005** at 6:00 P.M. EDT, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, or when limit is reached.

### Dogs Eligible to Enter

These events are open to **Border Collies** which have been registered with The American Kennel Club which are six (6) months of age or older. Obedience classes are also open to Border Collies that have been granted an ILP number which are six (6) months of age or older. Bitches in season may not compete in obedience classes.

### Move-Up Information

#### Note early date for prior to trial move-ups!

**Prior to the Obedience Trial:** Dogs shall be moved up to a higher obedience class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an obedience title, provided that the request is made to the Event Secretary not later than noon on Monday, October 3, 2005. E-mail notice is acceptable.

**Day-to-day:** Move-ups from Saturday to Sunday will be allowed. The request to move-up must be made to the Event Secretary no later than one hour after the final obedience class on Saturday.

- A separate entry blank must be completed for each dog entered. Please use care in clearly indicating which days, classes, courses (A or B) and stock you intend to enter for each dog.

**Award of Merit (Saturday):** The judge may, at his or her discretion, recall into the ring up to seven (7) dogs and/or bitches from the total Best of Breed entry to present an Award of Merit, to recognize the qualities of those animals the judge believes are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

**Award of Merit (Sunday):** As above, but up to four (4) dogs and/or bitches may be presented Awards of Merit.

**Herding Titled Classes:** For any dog or bitch that has earned an AKC herding title of Started or above on any course or livestock (i.e., Instinct Test certificate, Herding Test title, Pre-Trial Test title or non-AKC titles do not apply).

**Veteran Classes:** For dogs or bitches seven (7) years of age or older on the day of the show. Best Veteran and Best Opposite Sex to Best Veteran will be chosen after the Best of Breed judging is completed.

**Stud Dog Class:** For a Stud Dog and two to four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Stud Dog cannot be shown as the Get for another Stud Dog. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. Each dog making up the Get must be individually entered in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed Competition or a Non-Regular Class (other than the Stud Dog class) at this show.

**Brood Bitch Class:** Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get where appropriate.

**Novice Classes:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Classes:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and less than 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

**Junior Class:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.

**Intermediate Class:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show.

**Senior Class:** This class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

**Best Junior Handler:** Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

**Novice Jumpers with Weaves Preferred Class (NJP):** This class is not divided into A and B divisions. It is open to all dogs that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Open Agility Preferred title.

**Open Jumpers with Weaves Preferred Class (OJP):** Open only to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW Preferred title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Excellent JWW Preferred title.

**Excellent Jumpers with Weaves "A" Preferred Class (AJP):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW Preferred title and dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW Preferred title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent JWW Preferred title.

**Master Excellent Jumpers with Weaves "B" Preferred Class (MJP):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW Preferred title.

### **Obstacles, Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups**

All obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles as published in the *Regulations for Agility Trials*, as amended to December 2004. Walkthroughs are restricted to handlers entered in that class. There will **not** be any contact familiarization for novice dogs.

### **Height Divisions**

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Standard and Jumpers with Weaves Classes, dogs may jump at a higher height division; however, this is not allowed in the Preferred Classes.

### **Notice to Exhibitors**

- **Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs entered in agility are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Event Secretary.** Envelopes containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to sender.
- You may include a copy of your dog's official **jump height card** with your entry. If a copy is not included you will be required to present your card at check-in or have your dog measured by the judge. Dogs which jump at the 24" height will only be measured if there is an AKC Field Representative or a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) present.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will be refunded, less \$6.00 per day, for bitches that come in season after the closing date, provided the Event Secretary is notified, **in writing**, at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of classes each day.
- Any and all refund checks will be mailed by the BCSA Treasurer after the specialty.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- No telephone, fax, online entries or credit card payments will be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The BCSA Treasurer will add a \$20.00 collection to the amount of each returned check.
- **Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs to maintain the premises in a clean and tidy condition!**

### **Classification: Standard Agility Classes**

**Novice Agility Class (NA):** The Novice Agility Class is divided into Divisions A and B. Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-owner, or a member of the Owner's household. Handlers that co-own a dog and have never put an AKC Agility title on a dog may enter the Novice A Class regardless of the other co-owner's AKC Agility accomplishments. Dogs eligible for Novice A may be entered in the Novice B Class at the discretion of the Owner. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, or the Novice Jumpers with Weaves title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC Agility title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the Owner, Co-owner, or household member subject to the restrictions listed above. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice B Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open title.

**Open Agility Class (OA):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility or Open Agility titles but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Agility Excellent title.

**Agility Excellent "A" Class (AX):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility title, and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent title.

**Master Agility Excellent "B" Class (MX, MACH):** Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title, and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent title.

### **Classification: Jumpers with Weaves (JWW) Classes**

**Novice Jumpers with Weaves Class (NAJ):** The Novice Jumpers with Weaves Class is divided into Divisions A and B. Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-owner, or a member of the Owner's household. Handlers that co-own a dog and have never put an AKC Agility title on a dog may enter the Novice A Class regardless of the other co-owner's AKC Agility accomplishments. Dogs eligible for Novice A may be entered in the Novice B Class at the discretion of the Owner. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility title, or the Novice Jumpers with Weaves title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC Agility title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the Owner, Co-owner, or household member subject to the restrictions listed above. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice B Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open title.

**Open Jumpers with Weaves Class (OAJ):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW or the Open JWW titles but have not acquired a qualifying score towards an Excellent JWW title.

**Excellent Jumpers with Weaves "A" Class (AXJ):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW title and to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent JWW title.

**Master Excellent Jumpers with Weaves "B" Class (MXJ, MACH):** Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Excellent JWW title.

### **Classification: Preferred Classes**

A dog's owner may choose to enter the Preferred Standard Agility Class and Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class in lieu of entering the Regular Standard Agility Class and the Regular Jumpers with Weaves Class at any trial. The dog must be entered only in Preferred Classes or in Regular Classes, with no crossover between them being allowed at the same set of trials. Owners/dogs are allowed to switch back and forth between the Preferred Classes and the Regular Classes, but not at the same set of trials. All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level in both the Preferred Standard Agility Class and the Preferred Jumpers with Weaves Class regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard and JWW).

**Novice Agility Preferred Class (NAP):** This class is not divided into A and B divisions. It is open to all dogs that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Open Agility Preferred title.

**Open Agility Preferred Class (OAP):** Open only to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility Preferred title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent Preferred title.

**Agility Excellent "A" Preferred Class (AXP):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Preferred title and dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent Preferred title.

**Master Agility Excellent "B" Preferred Class (MXP):** Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred title.
