In Trial A each day, there will be a limit of thirty (30) total runs. In Trial/Test B each day, there will be a limit of twenty (20) total runs. Exhibition only entries will be accepted at the same fee and closing date as other entries. When numerical limits are exceeded, additional entries will be placed on alternates' list. Drawing for running order will be held at 5:30 P.M. EST, April 6, 2005 at the Trial Secretary's home.

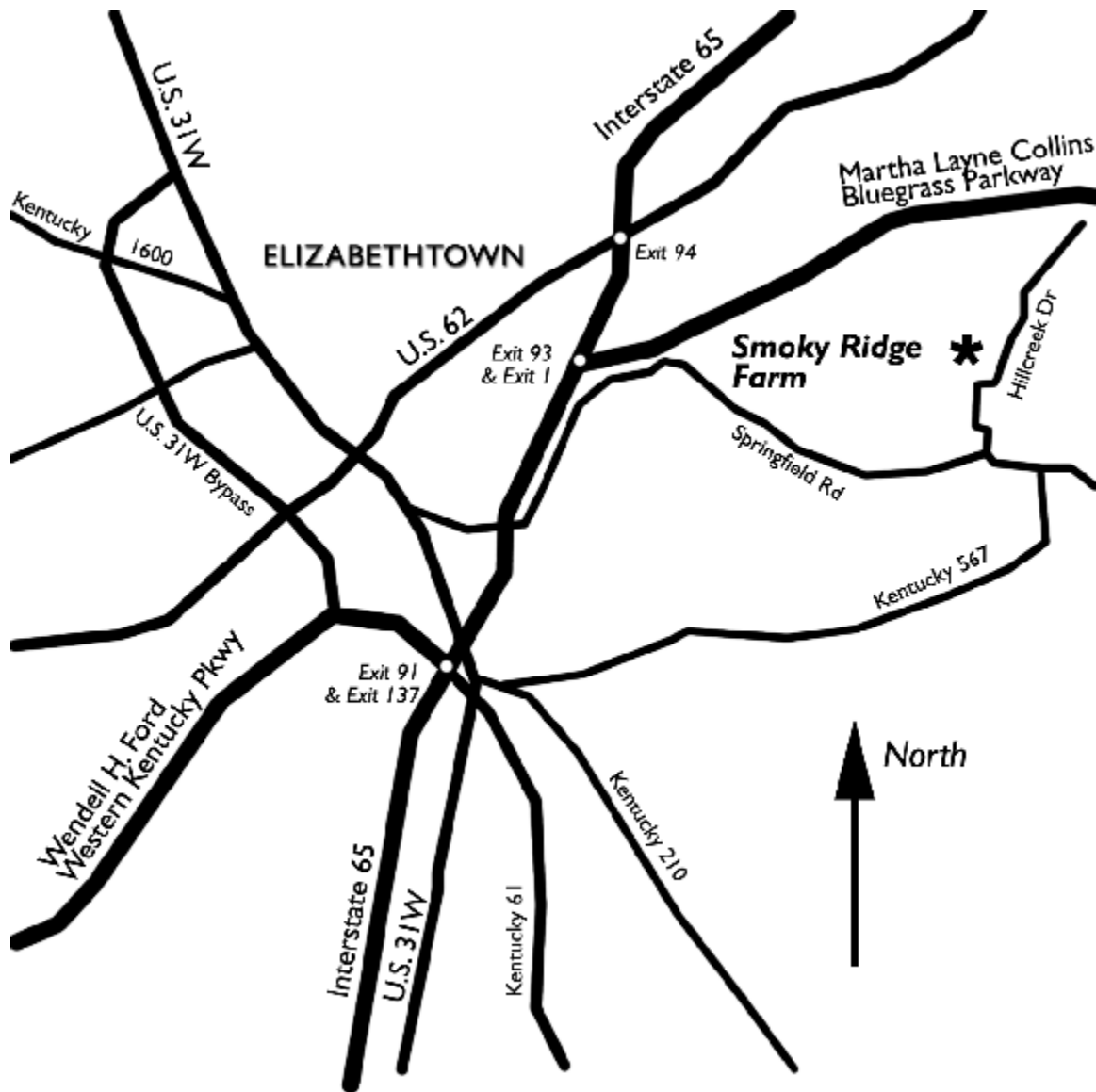

Notice to Exhibitors

- Entries will open at 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, February 2, 2005 Eastern Standard Time at the Trial Secretary's home. Entries received before that time will be returned. Hand-carried entries will be accepted.
- Make checks or money orders payable to the Central Kentucky Herding Group Club (CKHGC). All fees are payable in U.S. funds. Please type or print all information required on entry form. Entry fees are \$40.00 per trial per dog per class.
- Exhibition only entries will be accepted, with the same entry fee and closing time and date as regular entries.
- Credit card and e-Check Entries can be made online via PayPal at <http://www.laughing-coyote.com/>. There is an additional \$2.00 non-refundable fee for online entries to cover the Trial Secretary's processing costs.



- Entries close at 5:00 P.M. Eastern Daylight Time, Wednesday, April 6, 2005 at the Trial Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*. When numerical limits are exceeded, additional entries will be placed on an alternates' list.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's home on Wednesday, April 6, 2005 at 5:30 P.M. Eastern Standard Time.
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than thirty (30) minutes before the commencement of their class. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run in catalog order in Trial classes but will be placed at the end of the running order in Test classes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.
- The Central Kentucky Herding Group Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Central Kentucky Herding Group Club or any official thereof.
- The Test and Trial site is in the Eastern Time zone.
- There will be an hour's lunch break at the judge's discretion each day.
- Many restaurants are available in Elizabethtown, at Interstate 65, Exit 94. Lunch will be available for purchase on site.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Trial location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- The initial handlers' meeting will be held at 8:15 A.M. each day. Subsequent handlers' meetings will be held before each class.
- A separate entry must be made for each class.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*.
- This is a working farm, please take care to close and latch all gates.
- Please remember to bring shade, water, chairs and raingear.

Directions

From Louisville or north, take I-65 south. From Nashville or south, take I-65 north. From Lexington or east, take the Martha Layne Collins Bluegrass Parkway west to the end, and then follow the signs to I-65 south. From Paducah and the west, take the Wendell H. Ford Western Kentucky Parkway to the end, and follow directions from there.

From all these places proceed to the Elizabethtown/Hodgenville exit (#91). Follow signs as if you are going to Hodgenville until you get to the first red light, which is U.S. Route 31W (this is also the end of the WK Parkway). Turn left on U.S. 31W and proceed to the next light and turn right, between the Shell and Chevron stations (Kentucky 210). Go about a block and then turn left onto Kentucky 567 (Valley Creek Road). Go straight through the four-way stop sign and continue on about four miles to the Valley Creek Baptist Church. Note the cute lamb in the stained glass window. Turn left at the church onto Springfield Road, and then take the first street on the right, which is Hillcreek Drive. Hillcreek Drive is a winding country road, so be very careful of blind curves. Smoky Ridge Farm is on your left, with the name "Miller" on the mailbox and a sign with a sheep upon it. There is a long red barn, and you will be able to see the course from the road. If you get to the dead end, you've gone too far.
