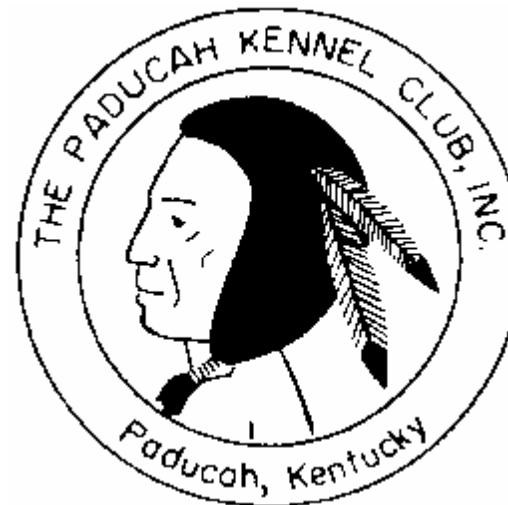

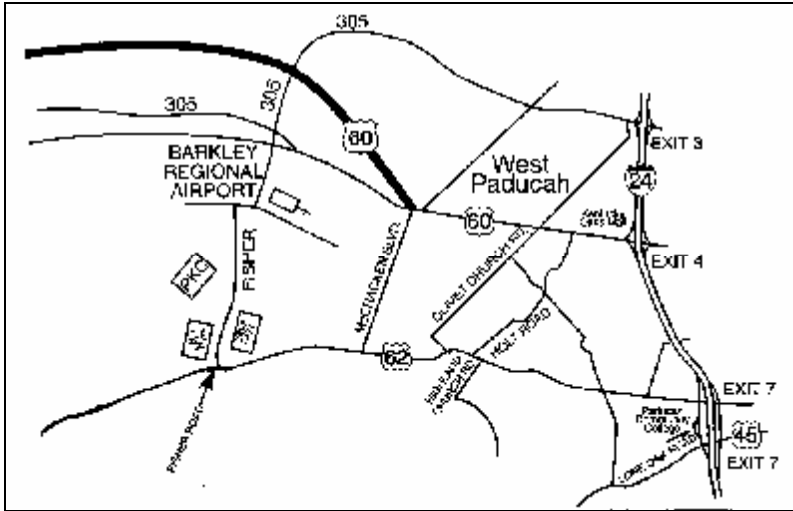

Directions

The Paducah Kennel Club show site and club building are located west of Interstate 24.

From the North: Take Exit 4 off Interstate 24. Take U.S. Route 60 west to Kentucky 305. Turn left (south) on Kentucky 305. You will pass the airport on your right and go through two stop signs. Continue on Kentucky 305 (Fisher Road) to the Paducah Kennel Club sign on your right, about 2 miles past the airport.

From the South: Take Exit 7 off Interstate 24. Take U.S. Route 62 west approximately 7.5 miles to Fisher Road. There is a BP Mart on the corner of U.S. 62 and Fisher Road. Turn right on Fisher Road and travel approximately ¼ mile to the Paducah Kennel Club sign on your left.
