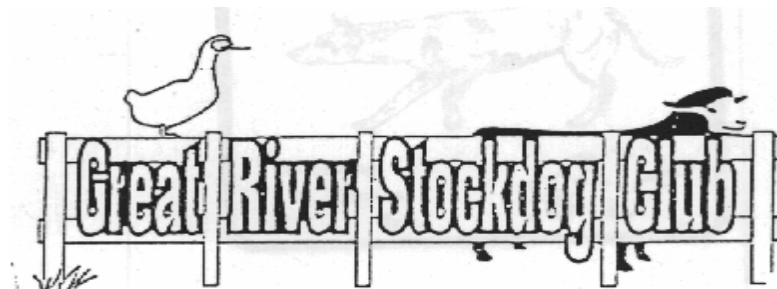

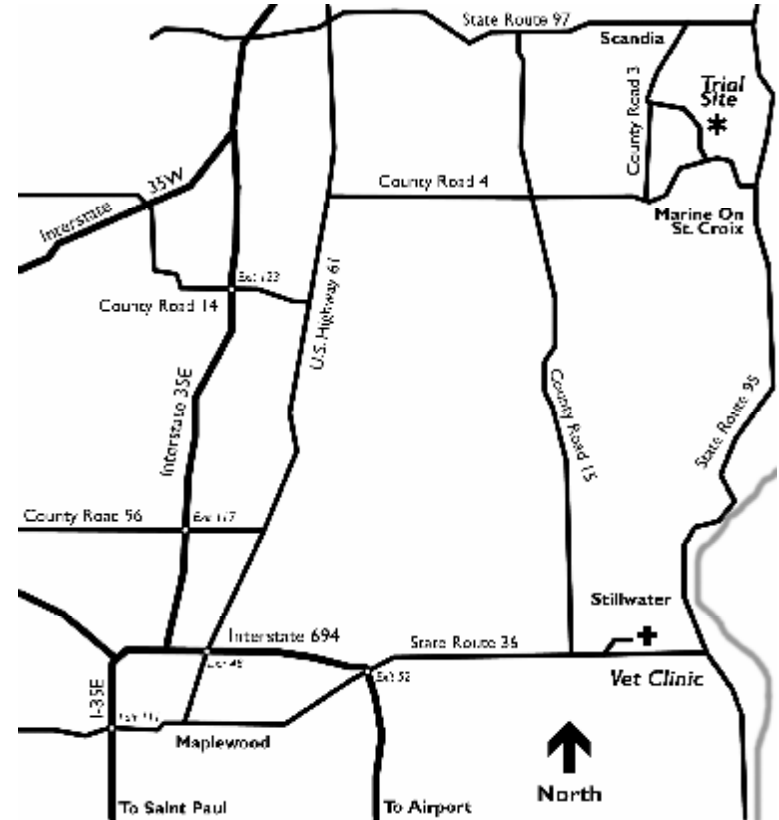

 - Turn right (east) on CR 4 and travel 9.6 miles to Parade Avenue North, which is a dirt road.
 - Turn left (north) on Parade Avenue N and travel for 0.3 miles to Old Marine Trail North.
 - Turn left (northwest) on Old Marine Trail N and travel 0.5 miles.

Course B Sheep outruns will be 150 feet for Started, 250 feet for Intermediate and 350 feet for Advanced. Course B Duck outruns will be 60 feet for Started, 75 feet for Intermediate and 100 feet for Advanced.

These trials and tests are open to all Herding breeds, Beaucerons, Giant Schnauzers, Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs, Rottweilers, Samoyeds, Standard Schnauzers, Norwegian Buhunds, Pyrenean Shepherds and Swedish Vallhunds which have been registered with The American Kennel Club or have been granted an ILP or FSS number, and which are nine (9) months of age or older. Giant Schnauzers, Greater Swiss Mountain Dogs, Standard Schnauzers, Norwegian Buhunds, Pyrenean Shepherds and Swedish Vallhunds may only enter trial classes as Exhibition Only entries.

- All cancellations must be written or e-mailed and received by the Trial Secretary before the closing date.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's home on Wednesday, June 7, 2006 at 6:30 P.M. Eastern Daylight Time.
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than thirty (30) minutes before the commencement of their class. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the event.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run in catalog order in Trial classes but will be placed at the end of the running order in Test classes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.

Schultz, PhD, Professor and Chair of the Department of Pathobiological Sciences, School of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Wisconsin–Madison. W. Jean Dodds, DVM, is both the organizer and supervisor of this project. A world-renowned veterinarian in the fields of hematology, immunology, endocrinology, nutrition and holistic medicine, Dr. Dodds in 1986 established Hemopet, the first nonprofit national blood bank program that benefits dogs throughout North America.
